

EFFECTS OF NICOTINE

Even in small doses, nicotine exposure in adolescence causes long-lasting changes in brain development, which could have negative implications for learning, memory, attention, behavior problems, and future addiction

KNOW

ADDICTION

Teens are especially vulnerable to possible addiction because their brains are not yet fully developed particularly the frontal regions that help with impulse control and assessing risk. Pleasure circuits in adolescent brains also operate in overdrive, making drug and alcohol use even more rewarding and enticing.

ANXIETY AND DEPRESSION

Nicotine makes anxiety and depression worse. It also affects memory, concentration, selfcontrol, and attention, especially in developing brains.

PREVALENCE

In 2024, e-cigarettes were the most commonly used tobacco product among middle and high school students in the United States:

- 1.63 million (5.9%) students currently used e-cigarettes. This includes:
 410,000 (3.5%) middle school students.
 - 1.21 million (7.8%) high school students.
- Among students who had ever used e-cigarettes, 43.6% reported current use.

NOT JUST NICOTINE

Pod-based e-cigarettes facilitate discreet vaping, helping users to easily consume nicotine and other drugs in public spaces, such as schools, while making their detection difficult. Personal vaping devices can also be modified to deliver THC (the most prevalent intoxicating compound in cannabis), methamphetamine, fentanyl, and synthetic cannabinoids. In fact, a third of youths who use personal vaping devices vape cannabis.
